We are again collecting brand new socks, toques and gloves. They will be donated locally. Please bring them to the school by Thursday, December 14.

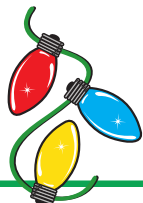


CHRISTMAS HAMPER TIME
